General Rules and Guidelines

1. A licensed driver must operate automotive and large vehicles. Small vehicles (mini-bike, small tractors, etc.) must be operated by a person age 16 or older.
2. All marching units shall be dressed uniformly and accompanied by an adult leader.
3. Youth organizations shall be accompanied by an adult.
4. Check in begins at 9:00 a.m. at intersection of North and Earl Garrett streets; judging at 10:00 a.m.
5. Judging will be based on general appearance, artistry, originality, animation, and costuming.
6. Entries must remain in position assigned unless approved by a parade official.
7. Rosettes will be presented for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
8. Best Overall Entry trophy winner will be chosen from 1st place entries in each category.
9. Parade will step off promptly at 11:00 a.m., rain or shine (bring rain gear).
10. No alcoholic beverage may be consumed before or during the parade.
11. All entries must be registered with liability waivers on file with Kerr County Fair Association.
12. No one is permitted to ride on a car top, fender, hood, etc.
13. No throwing is allowed of any type of object from parade entries for liability reasons and possible injuries per city ordinance. Items may be distributed by a walking parade participant as long as it does not impede parade movement or create a hazardous condition.
14. Silly string use is **not** permitted by parade participants or parade observers.
15. Equine entries must provide clean-up crews to remove any animal waste.
16. Parade route begins at intersection of North and Earl Garrett streets, proceeds south on Earl Garrett Street turning left on Water Street proceeding east, parade will disband on Water Street at "E" or "F" Streets.
17. Parade committee reserve the right to refuse any entries not conforming to family oriented quality and high standards. Failure to comply with rules may result in removal from parade and will affect future invitation to participate.
18. All parade committee decisions are final.

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
